

HEADWATERS COLLABORATION UPDATE

March 4, 2024 Meeting Summary

Our monthly Headwaters Collaboration meeting was graciously hosted by Zion Lutheran in Bagley.

- Pr. Rebel dwelled with us in Proverbs 4:1-7. She shared a devotion written by Kathy Levenhagen, Sacred Playgrounds, and we discussed the good soil that our faith was grown in and who helped us grow into who we are today. We shared a little of our own faith stories.
- 2. Communication: We went through the bulletin insert created last month and discussed how we would best use these to foster good communication with all. An example was shared, and adjustments were made. A representative from each church was identified to receive the monthly bulletin insert.
- 3. We discussed a shared webpage and calendar. It was determined that there needs to be a smaller working group to work on the details. We will discuss this more next month. Please reach out if you are interested in this work.

- **4.** A Chairperson for the group still needs to be identified. Pr. Rebel is on sabbatical this summer; so if no chairperson is identified, there will not be meetings in June and August. A Chairperson would do the work of convening people, creating an agenda, and finding someone to lead a devotion.
- **5.** Marylin Grandstrand is discerning staying in the area as a Synod Authorized Minister. For that to happen, she would need a lead on housing. Please let her know if you know of something available.
- **6.** Next meeting: April 16th will be held at Faith Lutheran in Bagley at 5:30 p.m. meal and fellowship and 6:00 p.m. meeting. See you there! Marilyn will lead devotions in April, and Destiny will lead devotions in May.

April 16, 2024 Meeting Summary

Our monthly Headwaters Collaboration meeting was graciously hosted by Faith Lutheran in Bagley.

- Marilyn Grandstrand, SAM, led the devotion time with us, dwelling on Acts 6, connecting the seven leaders with our seven congregations, our devotion to God, our commitment to prayer, and our care from the community.
